Guidelines for the Suit Yourself Closet

The Suit Yourself Closet offers <u>free</u> gently used professional clothing and styling support to VCU students.

It's yours to keep.

All clothing is free for students, and it is *not* a borrow system.



Come twice per month.

Students can visit the closet up to two times per month.

Full try-ons are allowed.

We now allow full try-ons, like a dressing room. Please refer to the other sign for instructions if you want to fully try something on.



Stay safe.

We ask that you use hand sanitizer before and after you visit the closet, and we encourage you to continue practicing social distancing.



Strategic Enrollment Management and Student Success

Take up to 6 items.

Students can take up to 4 *main items* and 2 *accessories* during each visit to the closet.

Accessories include ties, belts, shoes, jewelry, bags, scarves, suspenders, and other smaller items.



Visit our two SYCs.

We have two Suit Yourself Closets at VCU—one here and one on the other campus.

They are in the University Student Commons on Monroe Park Campus and Hunton Student Center on MCV Campus.





Items should be washed.

We do not wash items when they are donated. We encourage you to wash any pieces you take to ensure that they are ready for you to wear! When possible, donated items are steamed to help with cleanliness and presentation.
