- Visit O*Net at onetonline.org to explore career paths.** Browse groups of similar occupations to explore careers. Choose from industry, field of work, science area, and more.
- Complete your Handshake profile** and explore the suggested jobs, internships, and events page. These items are customized based on your skills and experience.
- Read about LinkedIn** and learn how to use it as a networking tool. Building out your Handshake profile is great practice for LinkedIn!
